This workshop will review some basics of climate science but will mostly explore strategic framing – a research-based approach to communications that provides opportunities for meaningful learning about climate change through conversations with visitors, students and other public audiences. Strategic framing uses values to explain why the issue matters, carefully selected metaphors to explain how the problem works and points toward actionable solutions that convey a sense of hope and empowerment.
